Last year your VFD responded to a total of 43 emergency calls and storm watches. This is thankfully down from the 51 calls in 2008. There was one large, dangerous grass fire that required evacuation of the residents across from Lamar Point Baptist Church and involved numerous volunteer fire department to fight the fire. We would like to thank all our residents for being careful when doing controlled burns and feel you have contributed to the low number of fire calls by your caution. Most calls were for grass or brush fires, but we did respond to structure fires, vehicle accidents/fires and some sick calls to assist the EMS. We really appreciate all our **volunteer** fire fighters who are willing to respond day or night to emergency calls. Our meeting day is the first Tuesday of each month at 7:00 P.M. Watch the signs in front of both Stations for place of meeting. We encourage everyone to attend the meetings to keep up to date on the activities of your VFD.

The fall was a busy time with our having a booth at the Red River Valley Fair and our annual Fall Carnival. Our thanks to the Texas Forest Service for providing a wonderful display and handouts as well as to the volunteers who worked the booth.

One large fire where we provided mutual aid was the Hope Agri Product fire in Powderly. Mutual aid is an agreement between VFDs to assist each other. Photo provided by The Paris News. We will be adding a bay to Station 1 at Lamar Point as we have three trucks in two bays. We will have not only the cost of construction but moving the water meter, power pole and putting in a new culvert. We appreciate any donations made to make this happen.
