We really appreciate all our **volunteer** fire fighters who are willing to respond day or night to emergency calls. Our meeting day is the first Tuesday of each month at 7:00 P.M. Watch the signs in front of both Stations for place of meeting. We encourage everyone to attend the meetings to keep up to date on the activities of your VFD.

The fall was a busy time with our having a booth at the Red River Valley Fair and our annual Fall Carnival. We had a large turn out and the adults had as much fun as the kids. Thanks to all who volunteer at both events.

Due to the efforts of Ronnie Bass we were able to make use of a Fire Training Trailer that was loaned by a private company. Through its use volunteer fire fighters are able to learn the dos and don'ts of fighting a fire. The trailer provides fire fighters with very advanced special training working with live fires and giving them practice on how to fight a fire from the initial fire to flashovers.
